NON-MEDICAL ACTIVITIES AND FOUNDATIONS:

1. The Michael J. Nissenblatt Partners in Healing Foundation:

Designed to give money to families simultaneously suffering from the financial hardship of the recession and from cancer. I created this Foundation with an attorney and his wife: Mr. and Mrs. Richard Anslow in December 2009. The Foundation has thus far funded a major construction on the home of a paraplegic man; paid for essential car repairs for a woman who had just been widowed because of her husband's lung cancer; funded the transportation costs for many patients receiving radiation therapy and chemotherapy; funded the costly "co-pays" for critical medications used to treat cancer patients; paid for the dental expenses of several patients needing dental and periodontal services; purchased an exercise bicycle for a young man fighting advanced Burkitt lymphoma during a lengthy 4 month hospital confinement. I have personally solicited the funding for the foundation and selected the recipients of the monetary awards.

2. The American Cancer Society:

My wife and I have been the Co-chairpersons for the dominant fund raising event in Middlesex County for the last 14 years. This annual Ball is called the Night of Wine and Roses. We have earned between \$150-250,000 each year, with all funds directed to the discretionary use of the ACS in funding patient care services, educational programs for the young, preventive services for those in mid age, and basic research at a National level. We have both been spokespersons for the ACS and Members of the Board for the last two decades.

3. The Challah Foundation:

I created this foundation in 1994. Every week (Friday) it distributes a loaf of bread called Challah and which is also known as the "Bread of Hope"..... to patients with cancer. Given to people of all ethnic, racial, and cultural backgrounds, it seeks to bring a sense of harmony, restoration, and hope to people with life threatening illnesses. We have distributed over 150,000 loaves of this Bread of Hope through the help of 10 volunteers who are from all stages of life and diversified religious and racial backgrounds. I have solicited funding for the Foundation, create letters of gratitude for donors, assist in the distribution of challah to patients, give educational and motivational talks to the volunteers, and create each week's of approximately 130 recipients.

4. Fred's Team:

This Foundation pays the bills of children with leukemia who are treated at Sloan Kettering. To join, one needs to run the New York City Marathon. I have run the Marathon for 13 years, and have been a member of this team for the last 6 years. In this effort I have collected ~\$165,000 to fight childhood leukemia. Among the 700-800 annual runners, my efforts usually place me among the top 10 fund raisers for the Foundation.

5. The Dr. Michael & Marlene Nissenblatt Scholarship:

This program is sponsored by the East Brunswick Regional Chamber of Commerce Charitable Foundation and by Dr. and Mrs. Nissenblatt. It offers 3 or 4 \$2000 scholarships each year to first or second year post-graduate students of Western medicine, traditional Chinese medicine, acupuncture and/or herbology who embrace and bring the human touch and human spirit to health care. I assist in generating funds, evaluating applicants and give an annual inspirational talk to the Chamber of Commerce and the selected honorees. To date there have been approximately 15-20 awards.
