Stephen K. Jones, FACHE, our Medical Honoree, is the President and CEO of Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital and Robert Wood Johnson Health System and has been the leading proponent of the new Barnabas-RWJUH health care merger. Steve will be the Chief Academic Officer, and will both integrate and oversee the role of UMDNJ-Rutgers Medical School and its 1,000 medical residents with 9,000 physicians distributed among 14 hospitals in 8 counties. Steve, previously honored with his wife Barbara, is now acknowledged for his continuing contributions both medically and financially to the cancer field.

Dr. Harish Malhotra, our Shining Star, is a psychiatrist who has fought lung cancer for 4 years. Through modern therapy, he has been in complete remission for nearly all of this time. As a psychiatrist, he understands the need to sublimate fear and has been transformative in his creative contributions since his diagnosis: three books, two plays, and numerous YouTube videos. Each creative expression exhibits his hopeful message of personal growth and metamorphosis. Dr. Malhotra has also been a continued and generous supporter of the Night of Wine and Roses, raising over \$25,000 in two years alone.

Last year's annual event united over 400 professionals in the fight against cancer and raised over \$340,000. These funds help the American Cancer Society carry out its mission of eliminating cancer as a major health problem through research, education, advocacy and service.
